Homework Assistance – The purpose of this program is to provide a safe, distraction free environment for students to start and complete homework assignments, as well as study for tests and quizzes. This program can benefit students by reinforcing study skills, time management, and organization skills. Furthermore, this environment provides a small group setting to start and complete homework. Teacher(s) and peer tutors will be available to assist students and answer general questions.

Supervised Study Hall – As a service to students and parents, we have recently implemented an after school study hall to support students in their academic work and to offer a supervised setting for students after normal school hours. The study hall runs from 3 – 6 pm.

Peer Tutoring – Upon request, a student is matched with a peer student to receive help with homework and understanding concepts, theories, and mathematical formulas.

Academic Workshops – The workshops assist students with identifying and applying study skills, time management, and test taking strategies and techniques.

Study Groups – Students study with their peers in a group setting to complete homework assignments and prepare for tests.

Small Groups – Groups on various topics (e.g., grief, adjusting to high school, good decision making, etc.) will be offered based upon student needs.

Online Resource – Naviance/Family Connection is a web-based software system that assists students with preparing for college, careers, and the workplace.
