Test Day Instructions:

1. Please arrive between 8:45 and 8:55 to sign in. The test will begin at 9am.
2. Students must bring at least two #2 lead pencils.
3. Students may bring a bottle of water. There will be only one brief bathroom break in the middle of the exam.
4. We recommend a good nights' sleep and solid breakfast before the exam.
5. Please arrive at 12:15 to pick your child up.
