



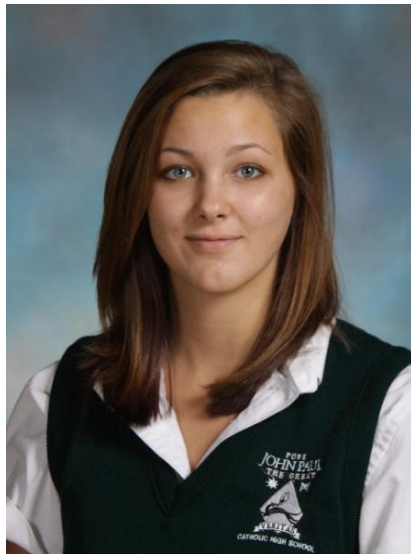

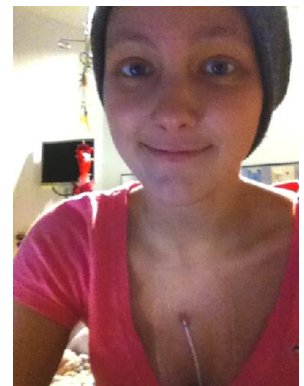


Before joining JP the Great, Sarah attended St. Thomas Aquinas Regional School. She was a member of Our Lady of Angels Parish, in Woodbridge.
