

How to apply for aid to Saint John Paul the Great Catholic High School through the DIOCESE OF ARLINGTON SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

Families whose Income Threshold is not greater than 300% above the federal poverty guidelines, and who currently attend public school, may qualify for aid through the newly established Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation. Please see below for criteria and application process.

Scholarships Recipient Criteria:

- Family income cannot exceed 300% of the federal poverty guidelines.
 - For Students with disabilities, the family's income cannot exceed 400% of the federal poverty guidelines.
 - Refer to the current **Federal Poverty Guidelines Worksheet** below.
- Additionally, recipients must be residents of Virginia, and
 - Transfer from public school or,
 - Transfer from out of state
 - Note: Transfers from home-school or other private schools do not qualify.
- OR, recipient must have received this scholarship the previous year.

How to Apply:

- Families must complete a financial aid assessment to verify income level through FACTS. Please click here to open or access your FACTS account: <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FY8M>
- In addition, if you believe you qualify for this program, please email Ms. Cole, Director of Admissions (admissions@jpthegreat.org), once you have applied for admission and for aid. This will flag your application for special review. Saint John Paul the Great will then complete the additional forms and submit to the Diocese of Arlington, Office of Catholic Schools. The Office of Catholic Schools cannot take applications directly from applicants.
- Standard admissions criteria apply to each applicant, regardless of scholarship qualification.
